WHEREAS, New York State's Sex Offender Registration Act was signed by Governor
George Pataki in July 1995, and became effective on January 21, 1996; and

WHEREAS, New York State's Sex Offender Registration Act requires registration as a sex
offender upon a conviction of a listed offense or a conviction for an attempt to commit a
listed offense; and

WHEREAS, New York State's Sex Offender Registration Act does not prohibit sex
offenders registered under the Act from living in close proximity to facilities where
children congregate (i.e. schools, playgrounds, parks, youth centers, registered day care
centers, etc.).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of North Tonawanda Common
Council hereby calls upon Governor George E. Pataki and the New York State Legislature
to amend the Sex Offender Registration Act to prohibit Level 2 and Level 3 sex offenders
from living within close proximity to schools, playgrounds, parks, youth centers, registered
day care centers, etc.

AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of North Tonawanda Common Council
hereby requests City Clerk Thomas M. Jaccarino to forward to all New York State Cities
and the New York Conference of Mayors and Municipal Officials a copy of the resolution
proposing a change to the Sex Offender Registration Act; and respectfully request their
support.
