XVII. Traffic Safety

After our September meeting we have come up with the following recommendations:

1. Put up a park entrance sign approximately 50 yards from the entrance to Miller Park (in the area of 1601 Sweeney St.). One on the South side of Sweeney St. and one on the North side.
2. Put up no parking between signs on Robinson St. in front of the entrance of 340 Robinson St. The signs should go up approximately 15 feet back from each side of the parking lot entrance to Larry's Trucking. The owner states his drivers have problems pulling into the lot on market days.
3. Take down the no parking signs in front of Lowery Middle School on the East side and West side of Payne Ave. Also the no parking signs on the North side of Hewitt St.
4. On Payne Ave. approaching Meadow Dr. (southbound direction) approximately 15 yards from the intersection put up a sign "right lane thru traffic only".
