Republic of Vietnam Gallantry Medal, the National Defense New York State Medal and the  
Conspicuous Service Cross.

Prior to his military service, Mr. Keller was a student athlete at North Tonawanda High  
School and a physical education teacher at Spruce School. In his short 24 years he was the  
embodiment of the Lumber City Spirit.

Be it further resolved that the Common Council directs the City Clerk to research the  
resolution passed requiring that all new city streets be named in honor of those North  
Tonawanda citizens who lost their lives in service to their county. The City Clerk will  
schedule a meeting with the mayor and Common Council to discuss the resolution and  
possible implementation of it in the future.
