RE: Compensation for City Treasurer effective January 1, 2008

Dear Honorable Body:

I am forwarding this communication pursuant to City Charter Section 3.025 entitled "Compensation" requesting that the Common Council pass an ordinance establishing the salary of the City Treasurer at \$50,000.00 effective January 1, 2008. This ordinance must be adopted no later than May 1 of this year. The new salary would take effect on January 1, 2008.

It should be noted that this ordinance would not immediately impact the salary that the newly appointed City Treasurer's is presently receiving which is \$59,900.00. Although, since there must be an election in November for the position the newly elected City Treasurer, would then be impacted by the ordinance effective January 1, 2008. I see this as a very reasonable cost saving measure, while the salary is still sufficient enough to attract qualified candidates to run for said position. This salary would be in line with the Mayor's present salary of \$50,000.00.

For some history, the salary for the position has risen over the years as follows:

2000 - \$49,741.00; 2001 - \$51,358.00; 2002, 2003 - \$53,027.00
2004, 2005, 2006, 2007 - \$59,900.00

I am assuming that the increases in salary over the years were based upon longevity and experience in the position. Accordingly, since the person elected as the City Treasurer in November will be a newcomer to the position and will not have the years of experience in said position, a reduction in the salary effective January 1, 2008 is very reasonable and justifiable in my opinion.

Please take the steps necessary to immediately discuss and implement this ordinance on or before May 1, 2007, as time is of the essence.
