

The Carousel Society of the Niagara Frontier has been planning 2 major projects for some time. Last January you passed resolutions in support of both a major structural project to save the clearstory building and the Kiddieland project which will place 4 Allan Herschell rides on the corner lot. I am excited to report to you that both projects are soon to be underway.

It is for this reason that I am writing to you now. The total of all parts of these projects is approximately \$675,000. In checking with the Building Department, I have learned that the permits would cost us \$2,816. This is an enormous fee for us to add to the cost of the projects, and is not covered by the grant funds received. It would have to come out of our very tight operating budget.

I am asking that you waive the permit fees for these projects. I would be happy to meet with you to discuss this request at your convenience. However, I hope to have a response shortly as we plan to erect the fence around the corner lot in the next 2-3 weeks.
