SEALED PROPOSALS for the construction work included in the Gratwick Riverside Park Marina Facilities Improvements, Project 2013-02, will be received by the City Clerk/Treasurer of the City of North Tonawanda, New York, until 11:00 am, Prevaling Time, Tuesday, June 11, 2013 at which time they will be publicly opened.

All bids shall be submitted to the City Clerk/Treasurer office in a sealed envelope addressed to the City of North Tonawanda and shall be plainly marked on the outside with the Contractor's name and title of the bid. Bids for contracts shall be designated as, Gratwick Riverside Park Marina Facilities Improvements, Project 2013-02.

Attention of bidders is particularly called to the requirements as to conditions of employment to be observed and minimum wage rates to be paid under the contract.

The minimum wage rates to be paid to laborers and mechanics engaged in the construction of this project shall be the latest wage rates established by the State Industrial Commissioner.

Funding for this project comes in part through a United States Fish and Wildlife Service Boating Infrastructure Grant administered by the New York State Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation (OPRHP). Under Article 15A, Executive Law, the State of New York is committed to providing Minority and Women Owned Business (MWBE) equal opportunity to participate in government contracts. The following goals have been set for this project: 20% of the contract value for MBE's and WBE's combined. The successful bidder is required to furnish an EEO policy statement and reports showing the participation of various business enterprises of subcontractors and suppliers on the contract.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids for failure to comply with the requirements of the Contract Documents but may, at its discretion, waive any informalities or irregularities.

The Owner further reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to award a contract which, in its judgment, is in the best interest of the Owner.





Action is required by the City to clear a title problem within the Daigler Drive Subdivision. The problem began in 1953 when Cornelia Starr conveyed a parcel to the city which ran from the power company lines to the cul-de-sac on the west end of Daigler Drive. However, in 1994, the City approved the Daigler Subdivision with a cul-de-sac at the east end of the subdivision. Therefore, the part of the paper street that lies within subdivision lots number 33 and 34 is no longer needed by the City.



Attached please find a Memorandum of Agreement between the City and OPEIU regarding the placement of the Chief of Police within the OPEIU bargaining agreement. Prior to now, the state law required the chief to be paid a greater annual salary and benefits than the highest paid member of the police collective bargaining unit. This law has recently been repealed. The city would now have to negotiate a separate contract with the chief or place him within an existing bargaining unit.

The proper bargaining unit for the chief would be the OPEIU which is the bargaining unit representing all other department heads. The city and union have already negotiated the proper placement within the union. If you concur, please approve the attached Memorandum of Agreement. Thank you.

Re: Local Law #1 for 2013--Addition of Chapter 30 to the City Code

Dear Honorable Body:

Attached for your consideration is Local Law No.1 for 2013, which would add to Chapter 30 of the North Tonawanda City Code a local law entitled, "Deconversion Tax Rebate."

This addition would provide for a tax rebate for property owners who deconvert multi-family dwellings into single-family dwellings. Section 1 of the proposed local law concerns tax rebate eligibility. Eligibility requirements include converting a multi-family dwelling into a single-family dwelling and obtaining proper certification from the City Building Inspector. Section 2 pertains to the calculation of the rebate, which would allow for a 10-year tax rebate for eligible property owners. The rebate would be equal to the property owner's City tax bill, or \$1,000 annually, whichever is less. Section 3 provides that a Certificate of Occupancy indicating that the building has been converted to a single-family dwelling is necessary for the rebate, and that noncompliance with this provision would result in a revocation of the rebate.

As with all local laws, it is necessary for this local law to be formally laid on the table for a period of at least 7 days, wherein it must stay in its final form. After a period of at least 7 days, the local law must be scheduled for a public hearing before the Common Council. Once the public hearing has been completed the law may then be passed for adoption by the Common Council. Once it has been adopted by the Common Council, and the law has been formally filed with the Secretary of State, the local law will become effective.

Consistent with State law, the appropriate motion for today's action would be to receive and file this local law and lay it on the table for at least 7 days in its final form. A public hearing can be held before the Common Council anytime after the 7 day "aging period" has lapsed.
