



Dear Honorable Mayor & Common Council Members:

There is currently a request by the owners of 467 River Road to obtain ownership of a small section of Judd Alley, which is adjacent to their property. After discussion with the City Assessor and further review of the matter, it is our opinion that the piece of the alley be abandoned. The section of the alleyway in question was fenced off when the current owners purchased the property in the 1980s and they have been maintaining it since that time. As you are aware, the City often abandons parts or all of alleyways when they are no longer in use, and this parcel currently serves no public purpose. Furthermore, the County tax map already indicates that this piece of the alley is part of 467 River Road. Therefore, for the reasons stated above, it is our recommendation that this section of the alleyway be abandoned and deeded to the owners.





As you are aware, our office represents Paul L. Overkamp, who appeared before the Planning Board on September 8, 2014, to subdivide some vacant property on River Road for a future sale of said property.

I have recently provided a Survey by Bissell Stone Associates dated April 10, 2014, Job No. 56461, and a Legal Description of said property. Also provided was a survey of the property to be subdivided, by Stephen S. Suita & Associates, Job No. 89502, dated June 26, 1989.

At the September 8<sup>th</sup> meeting the Planning Board was concerned regarding the status of Judd Alley on the Bissell Stone survey, and whether said Judd Alley was abandoned. Said Alley has been fenced off from the Overkamp's property since 1989-1990 to date; Has not been in use for the same number of years; and has also been covered with grass, not pavement for over 20 years..


I understand that since the property fronts on River Road, Niagara County must be notified of this subdivision request.




Dear Honorable Body:

As you are aware, the City of North Tonawanda received a \$575,000 Green Infrastructure Grant from the New York State Environmental Facilities Corporation to construct new biofiltration units to replace the planter boxes on Webster Street, as well as installation of porous pavement strips and an interpretive sign. Approval of the six (6) required change orders and approval of the final payment and project acceptance is respectfully requested.

The following is a list of the field changes required to complete the work:

1. Resetting of existing brick pavers	\$1,100.00
2. Installation of new brick pavers	\$52,260.65
3. Installation of electric handholes for tree lighting	\$5,525.00
4. Inlet reduction curb at 17 Filterra units	\$11,000.00
5. Storm sewer separation from Sweeney to Tremont	\$12,500.00
6. Contract quantity overruns	<u>\$23,795.12</u>
<b>Total</b>	<b>\$106,180.77</b>

Accordingly, I respectfully request that the Common Council approve the change order in the amount of \$106,180.77 for the Webster Street Green Infrastructure Improvements Project, increasing the contract amount to Yarussi Construction, Inc., 5650 Simmons Avenue, Niagara Falls, NY 14304, from \$406,325.00 to the final payment amount of \$512,505.77; authorizing the Mayor to sign said change order, subject to review by the City Attorney.
