**SUMMARY OF BOND RESOLUTION**

Set forth below is a summary of said resolution adopted by the Common Council of the City of North Tonawanda on April 7, 2015.

1. The resolution is entitled "BOND RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH TONAWANDA, NIAGARA COUNTY, NEW YORK (THE "CITY") AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$2,538,102 IN SERIAL BONDS OF THE CITY TO FINANCE VARIOUS PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS".

the City's Department of Public Works, in the principal amount of \$270,000; PPU of 15 years;

- (j) the acquisition of one dump truck and one plow truck for use by the City's Youth, Recreation and Parks Department at the Deerwood Golf Course, and the construction of a new golf paths and the reconstruction of culverts, including appurtenant and related improvements, in the principal amount of \$80,000; PPU of 15 years;
- (k) purchasing one landscape body truck with unicell for use by the City's Parks Department, in the principal amount of \$41,630; PPU of 15 years;
- (l) purchasing equipment for use by the City's Accounting Department consisting of computer hardware and related software, in the principal amount of \$66,000; PPU of 5 years;
- (m) improvements to the City Water Pump Station consisting of (i) the reconstruction and replacement of existing roofing with a spray roofing system, (ii) the acquisition and installation of variable frequency drives for high speed pumps #1 and #2, and (iii) the acquisition and installation of chlorine regulators, in the principal amount of \$160,000; PPU of 15 years; and
- (n) certain improvements to the Wastewater Treatment Plant located at 830 River Road, consisting of (i) the acquisition and replacement of by-pass gates, and (ii) the acquisition, installation and replacement of fine screen with mechanical rakes and conveyor, in the principal amount of \$550,000; PPU of 40 years.

3. Aggregate amount of Debt Obligations Authorized: up to \$2,538,102.

Dear Honorable Body:

On Monday, April 27, 2015 one bid was received and opened by the City Clerk for the rebidding of Erie Canal Kayak Launches Project. As you may be aware, the original bids received on January 13, 2015 came in well above the allotted budget of \$104,700, causing the city to redesign and rebid the project. Unfortunately during the rebidding process the legal advertisement did not properly reach the newspaper and therefore the Common Council's April 7, 2015 award of the project must be rescinded and re-approved based upon the legally published advertisement subsequently appearing in the Niagara Gazette on April 18, 2015.

The project is funded through a \$71,350 an Environmental Protection Fund Grant from New York State Department of State and a \$50,000 appropriation from the City's 2014 Capital Budget.

Accordingly, I respectfully request that the Common Council award the Erie Canal Kayak Launches Project to NFP and Sons, Inc., 7311 Ward Road North Tonawanda, NY 14120, at their low total bid amount of \$103,500; authorizing the Mayor to sign said contract subject to review by the City Attorney.


Honorable Body,

The company has provided this service for the past two years of concerts, and have not increased their fees of \$195.00 per hour.



## EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES COVERAGE AGREEMENT

Agreement entered into this 20th day of April 2015, between Twin City Ambulance Corp. ("TCA"), located at 555 Commerce Drive, Amherst, NY 14228 and The City of North Tonawanda ("North Tonawanda"), located at 216 Payne Avenue, North Tonawanda, New York 14120.

### Recitals

- A. North Tonawanda is a city which has partnered with a promoter to provide a series of concerts ("Concert Series") and North Tonawanda wishes to procure ambulance stand-by service for the Concert Series. The Concert Series is scheduled at the following dates and times:

Friday, July 10, 2015 from 15:30 until 23:00  
Friday, July 17, 2015 from 15:30 until 23:00  
Friday, July 31, 2015 from 15:30 until 23:00  
Friday, August 7, 2015 from 15:30 until 23:00

- B. TCA is an ambulance service that provides all levels of EMS to the communities it serves and TCA wishes to provide such services to North Tonawanda for the above reference event.

In consideration of the foregoing recitals, mutual covenants and promises set forth below, and for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, North Tonawanda and TCA hereby agree as follows:

1. Arthur G. Pappas is the Mayor of North Tonawanda and as such is vested with the authority to act on behalf of and legally bind North Tonawanda.
2. Terence P. Clark is the President of TCA and as such is vested with the authority to act on behalf of and legally bind TCA.
3. TCA shall not be responsible for any filing fees associated with the public function permit application required by 10 NYCRR Part 18 ("Part 18").
4. North Tonawanda shall prepare the public function permit application required by Part 18 and provide copies of that application to the New York State Department of Health, TCA, and any other agency which requests a copy.
5. North Tonawanda shall be responsible for ensuring that all Part 18 requirements are satisfied.

6. North Tonawanda shall complete all post event reports required by Part 18. North Tonawanda shall then forward copies of those reports to the New York State Department of Health.
7. TCA shall provide EMS, supplies, and equipment as requested by North Tonawanda.
8. With regard to EMS staffing for the concert series, TCA shall provide one (1) Advanced Life Support (“ALS”) ambulance appropriately staffed and equipped at a rate of \$195 per hour. At its option, North Tonawanda may request TCA to provide additional staffing. In such a case, North Tonawanda shall use best efforts to notify TCA as early as possible of the need for additional staffing. Additional staffing will be provided at a rate of \$195 per hour per unit.
9. TCA shall have the requested resources on-site during the times indicated in Recital A. In the event that the times in which TCA is requested to be on-site change from what is specified in Recital A, North Tonawanda shall notify TCA at least 24 hours prior to the start of the affected event(s).
10. TCA shall be designated as the exclusive ambulance provider used by North Tonawanda for its EMS coverage needs at the Concert Series.
11. When EMS is needed during a time which TCA is not providing on-site EMS coverage, the Concert Series staff shall dial 911 and request EMS through the local 911 system.
12. TCA shall bill Medicare Part B, Medicaid, and other third party insurers its usual and customary fees for any ambulance transportation provided to patrons of the Concert Series. With the exception of workers’ compensation claims for which North Tonawanda is determined to be legally responsible, North Tonawanda shall not be held financially responsible for any ambulance transports originating from the Concert Series.
13. North Tonawanda shall within 30 days of receipt of the billing statement render full payment to TCA.
14. TCA shall provide quality, certified staff, all members of which shall be fully trained in accordance with all federal, state, and local laws, rules, and regulations.
15. In the event of a major disaster requiring the evacuation of the Concert Series, TCA shall, subject to equipment and manpower availability, utilize its resources to provide support and ambulance transportation.

16. TCA shall complete appropriate patient care / transport reports for all patients treated at and transported from the Concert Series.
17. North Tonawanda and TCA understand and agree that TCA is, and at all times during the term of this Agreement shall be, an independent contractor and nothing herein shall be construed as inconsistent with that relationship or status. Without limiting or modifying the foregoing, it is further understood and agreed that the personnel of TCA and North Tonawanda shall not be considered agents or employees of the other and shall not be under the supervision, management, direction, or control of the other in the performance of their respective duties.
18. TCA shall maintain, at its own expense, general liability insurance, professional medical malpractice liability insurance, and automotive liability insurance covering bodily injury and property damage, with a combined single limit of at least \$3,000,000, as well as workers' compensation and disability insurance as required by the State of New York.
19. The term of this Agreement shall commence on the day and year first written above and shall expire at the conclusion of the Concert Series.
20. Any notice required or permitted to be given pursuant to any provisions of this Agreement shall be given in writing, and either delivered in person, by electronic transmission (with copy of notice and confirmation of receipt simultaneously transmitted by mail or overnight courier), deposited in the United States mail, postage pre-paid, registered or certified mail, return receipt requested, properly addressed, or by a nationally recognized overnight courier service, to the following addresses:

21. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of New York without regard to principles of conflicts of laws.

22. No right or obligation hereunder may in any way whatsoever be assigned or delegated to any third party without the prior written consent of the other party and any attempted assignment without such consent shall be deemed null and void. Notwithstanding the foregoing, this Agreement and the rights and obligations hereunder may be assigned or delegated to any of TCA's affiliates who shall assume all obligations hereunder and provided that TCA remains liable.
23. This Agreement shall be binding upon and shall inure to the benefit of the parties hereto, and their respective successors and assigns.
24. If any portions of this Agreement shall be for any reason invalid or unenforceable, the remaining portions shall be valid and enforceable and carried into effect unless to do so would materially deprive the other party of the benefit of its bargain.
25. This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement and understanding of the parties with respect to the subject matter hereof, and this Agreement supersedes all previous understandings or agreements, oral or otherwise. No modification of this Agreement shall be valid unless in writing and signed by each of the parties hereto.
26. This Agreement may be executed in multiple counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which together shall constitute one and the same document.


Traffic Safety Minutes:

The April meeting of the North Tonawanda Safety Committee was called to order at 1900 hours. Roll call showed the following members present: J. Sikora, R. Frank, M. Lemke, A. Vater, E. Smolinski, A. DiBernardo, and M. Daigler. There were no minutes from the March meeting, the agenda items were discussed. And a motion to add the March items to the April minutes was carried. The following new requests/concerns were discussed and recommendations made.

1. Member Daigler reported adjustments to the road grade in the area of the railroad tracks and Ward Road will be addressed during paving season.
2. Motion R. Frank, second E. Smolinski, to remove no parking signs along Payne Avenue from Sweeney to Tremont. Motion passed unanimously.
3. Member Smolinski requested moving current "no parking here to corner" signs located on Thompson St. at Payne and Lincoln at Thompson closer to the corners to create a few additional parking spots. Member Daigler will look into the request. The Committee is in favor.
4. 4. Member Sikora will contact NYS DOT on the status of cross walks being placed at River Road intersections to make access to the bike path easier.
5. A request from resident Kevin Hodgson to cut back vegetation near the intersection of Plastic and Euclid was discussed and will be looked at when the growing season starts.
6. A request from resident Joseph Mantione to place "children at play" signs on Niagara Street between Christiana and Thompson was discussed. The Committee feels that since all neighborhoods in the City have children living in them that "children at play" signs should be used for schools and playgrounds only. If there is a speeding problem in the area it can be addressed with additional enforcement by the NTPD. The Committee does not recommend placing the requested signs.
7. A letter from William Sparks to the Committee thanking them for actions taken at the intersection of Fredericka Street and Payne Avenue was received.

Meeting adjourned at 1950 hours.






