Honorable Council,

I have submitted a Budgetary Transfer Request to move \$2600.00 from Operations to Public Safety lines.

This request is to secure the service of an experienced FEMA grant writer. I have met with Mr. Michael Penzotti, President of "GrantMasters Inc., to discuss the costs of filing a grant application to replace the Department "Self Contained Breathing Apparatus" which are due to expire in 2016. His fee to write this grant totals \$2600.00, of which we can request reimbursement of up to \$1500.00.


While I understand the City employs Michael Zimmerman to write Municipal Grants, he has admitted that the specialized knowledge needed would be a challenge for him to succeed. This Department has attempted to write a successful grant for the past four (4) years.

As a quick background on this Company, the Department used his service four (4) years ago to secure a "Volunteer Recruitment Grant" totaling \$74,000.00. His success rate for all grants he has written is at 72-75%, and this year alone he has successfully written 18 of 19 grants for the exact same equipment.

As with our "turn-out gear", the SCBA units allow us to enter unsafe situations and continue to breathe. Without it we can barely get close to a structure due to smoke and/or other toxins. The basic cost for one unit is in the area of \$7000.00, and this Department carries fifty (50) units. This would mean that if they are not replaced by a grant, we must bond nearly \$500,000.00 for 2016-2017.

The success rate speaks for itself and I respectfully request this transfer as soon as possible due to filing deadlines set for early November 2015.
