



Approval of Change Order No. 4 and Final Project Acceptance is hereby requested. Change Order No. 4 is based on the final measured quantities of the contract which reduces the authorized contract amount by \$114,147.89.

I therefore respectfully request that the Common Council approve Deduct Change Order No.4 for Project 2003-07, The Frederick B. 

NO PARKING signs put up on show days for the block


