**Dear Council Members:**

As you know, this winter season has been particularly mild and has not involved as much snow plowing and roadwork as is usually necessary between November and April. That being said, it has been suggested that the City lift its overnight parking ban immediately, rather than extend it until the usual ending date of April 1, as established by City Code §96.9. This would be a one –time rollback for this 2017 year only.

Should your Honorable Body concur, please pass a resolution to allow a rollback of overnight parking enforcement to tomorrows date from its usual ending date of April 1, as a one-time rollback for the spring of 2017, subject to further review by the City Attorney.
