

Park Shelter Permits

Park permits for Mayor's, Pine Woods, Raymond Klimek Veteran's Park and Gratwick-Riverside Park can be obtained in the Recreation Office at the Norman Keller building at 500 Wheatfield Street. Permits must be obtained in person (residents only) and will be **available for rental starting Saturday, March 1, 2014 at 9 a.m.** We use a lottery system for the first day of permits only. After this day permits will be available in the Recreation Office from 8:00 am - 5:00 pm. Permits can be purchased using cash, check or money orders. A \$50 fee is charge per park shelter. Shelters with a kitchen are \$60. This fee is not refundable. Park shelters are available for rental from May 23th through September 1st on a first come, first serve basis. Pine Woods (large shelter) will be available on a limited basis after Labor Day through the end of September.

RULES FOR RENTERS:

1. Any alteration to Permit invalidates the permit.
2. Permit holder must bring permit with him/her to the park at the starting time and display it for public viewing on the day of the reservation.
3. Permit holder must be on site at the starting time of the reservation. Park attendance will only wait 15 minutes. If the party is late, the permit is canceled. If the picnic ends early, someone for the party must wait until the attendant arrives to secure the shelter. Any change to shelter reservation can be made up to four working days before the event. Please call 695-8520.
4. The party will be responsible for leaving the shelter and area in a neat and tidy condition. Anyone abusing the privilege will not be issued a permit for next season. Any damages or excessive cleanup incurred to shelter and area will be billed to permit holder. (See rules posted in pavilion).
5. Vehicles parking in restricted areas will be ticketed by the Police Department.

PARK DESCRIPTIONS:

PINE WOODS PARK - Playground area, permanent lavatories, horseshoe and volleyball courts. Hook ups for beer truck. Both have full service kitchens with electricity, water, stove and refrigerator. Rental fee \$60 each

MAYOR'S PARK – Permanent lavatories, playground apparatus, horseshoe and volleyball courts, electricity and hook up for beer truck.

- **PERMITS WILL NOT BE ISSUED ON NIGHTS WHEN BAND CONCERTS ARE SCHEDULED**

Shelter 1 – Capacity 80 (near water)
Horseshoe courts and volleyball court
Electricity and hook up for beer truck
Shelter 2 – Capacity 120 * Handicap Accessible
Horseshoe and bocce courts
Electricity but NO hook up for beer truck
No Vehicle Road to shelter – handicapped maybe dropped off at shelter

GRATWICK-RIVERSIDE PARK – Playground apparatus, portable lavatories, handicap fishing pier and boat launch with permit
Shelter 1 – Capacity 120 *Handicap Accessible
Grill is available at shelter. NO WATER available

Overnight parking permit fee - Gateway Harbor Docking Facilities:
