Mayor Robert G. Ortt to Deliver The State of the City of North Tonawanda Address on Wednesday, February 5th

The State of the City presentation is open to the public and will be delivered at 1:00 p.m. The address will immediately follow a luncheon which begins at 12:00 p.m. (Noon) by the Rotary Club of the Tonawandas. Highlights of the address will include the continuing need to keeping costs and taxes down, looking at new ways to deliver services, infrastructure upgrades, the rehabilitation of Oliver St., and continuing to bring city government into the 21st century through technology upgrades.
