## Mayor Pappas Announces New Street Sweeper for City

NORTH TONAWANDA—North Tonawanda Mayor Arthur G. Pappas announced that a new street sweeper was purchased for the Department of Public Works, and is currently in use throughout the City. This state-of-the-art sweeper, made by the Johnston Sweeper Company, is a much better model than the aged sweeper the city has been using for the past 22 years.

The City has over 230 lane miles of road that it maintains, and this new sweeper will help keep debris material off the curb line so it doesn't get to the receivers. By keeping the receivers free of leaves and grit, this will assist with the ponding on roads and less maintenance required.

"Besides sweeping the streets, this piece of equipment will be used during paving season in cleaning up the crumbs before asphalt is laid down," stated Brad Rowles, Superintendent of Public Works. "The sweeper also has a vacuum attachment that can be used as a backup to our Vactor for cleaning city receivers, and can be used as an additional tool during leaf pickup season."

"The advanced technology of this sweeper is designed to provide years of continuous performance and reliable service," stated Mayor Pappas. "Replacing this aged equipment will be much more beneficial for the City, and is necessary in keeping our streets clean."
