Mayor Pappas Announces Ground Breaking Ceremony for New Raymond Klimek Veterans Park Band Shell

NORTH TONAWANDA—Mayor Arthur G. Pappas will join Niagara County Legislator Rich Andres, North Tonawanda Director of Parks and Recreation Patty Brosius, as well as additional City and County Officials, for a ground breaking ceremony in dedication of a new open air band shell in Raymond Klimek Veterans Park.

The band shell was purchased at a cost of \$89,836, with funds provided by a grant obtained through the Niagara River Greenway Commission, in the amount of \$90,000, with an additional \$25,000 provided by the City of North Tonawanda in kind. The new structure will replace the aging event stage purchased in 2003.
