The February 2017 meeting of the North Tonawanda Traffic Safety Committee was called to order at 1900 hours. Roll call showed the following members present: R. Frank, M. Lemke, E. Smolinski, and J. Sikora. The minutes from the previous meeting were read and accepted. The following new requests were discussed and recommendations made.

1. Request for placement of a handicapped parking spot, in the street, in the area of 25 First Avenue was discussed. The Committee does not recommend placement of parallel handicapped parking spots in the street and has denied recommending them in the past. Additionally, parking would not be permitted over night during the winter parking ban. After the discussion the Committee agreed to not recommend placement of the handicapped parking spot.
- ✓ 2. An application for a Terrace Parking Permit was received form 155 Wheatfield Street. The Committee approves this request with the stipulation this permit is for non commercial passenger vehicles only!
3. NTPD reported on truck traffic along 9<sup>th</sup> Avenue/Walck Road. Some truck traffic has been seen along this section of road. The area will continue to be watched and tickets issued when necessary.






