On May 17, 2016, your honorable body granted the Mayor permission to develop a
memorial garden and remembrance walk, known as the Children's Memorial Garden, at
Brauer Park. Initially, permission was granted for use of the park only and funding for the
project was intended to be by donation only. However, the Mayor has received
overwhelming support on the project and has also been notified that there is grant funding
available to the City to support his project.

In order to apply for and receive available grant monies, the Children's Memorial Garden must be established as a City project. To move forward, the Council needs to consider adopting the Children's Memorial Garden as a Capital Project for the fiscal year 2017 Budget. Appropriations for this project shall be limited to the amount of estimated revenues received, to eliminate any cost burden to the taxpayers for the completion of this project.

If your honorable agrees to adopt the project for 2017, the City must commit to advance the funds, as they relate to the grant award from DASNY State and Municipal Facilities Program ("SAM") Project ID#7475, to complete this project.

- 1. Canal Fest will be held July 16th through July 23th 2017.
- The use of Gateway Park on Sweeney St between Main Street and Webster St for the purpose of setting up tents by our members and for the use of entertainment. As in the past, the beer tent may go up as soon as **Thursday**, **July 13th** with all tents to be removed no later than the eve of **Monday**, **July 24th** (canal side) and noon (building side).
- Barricades to be placed for closing of the Renaissance Bridge by 5:00pm on Friday, July 14th and at other locations as necessary. Water connections at the Pavilion and other locations across Sweeney will be required at this time also.
- 4. Tim Frank 4 Mile Run. Sweeney Street between Main Street and approx Mayor's Park for the use of the 4 Mile Run coordinated by The Boy's and Girl's Club of the Tonawandas on Thursday, July 20st with Sweeney closed off accordingly for a race start 7:00pm.
