

GHD Consulting Services Inc. (GHD) is pleased to submit two copies of our proposal in response to the City of North Tonawanda's Request for Proposal (RFP) for Topographic Survey for 2017 Storm Sewer Separation Projects. We have thoroughly reviewed the RFP, aerial photographs of the proposed project area, and conducted a site walk of the area in preparation of this proposal.

GHD maintains its own in-house topographic survey crew and equipment. For this project, data collection will be completed utilizing a Leica survey grade GPS and robotic total station instrument and data collector. The data collected will be provided to our-in-house CAD staff for development of the base map requested by the City. The base map will be created in the latest edition of AutoCAD.

1. Project Understanding

It is our understanding that the City intends to separate approximately 3,400 linear feet (LF) of storm sewerage from the existing combined sanitary sewer system along portions of 5th Avenue (1,000 LF), Porter Avenue (1,300 LF), Riverview Avenue (700 LF), and Ward Road (400 LF). We further understand that the City wishes to obtain a topographic survey, cross-sections, and establish baselines and stationing for the project area for the purpose of preparing plans and specifications for the 2017 Storm Sewer Separation Project with construction during the 2017 construction year.

2. Scope of Services

2.1 Basic Service

GHD will conduct a topographic survey of the proposed area including the location and mapping of surface topography within and 10 feet beyond the Right-of-Way (ROW). Elevations for the survey shall be based on the City's datum. Our survey will include:

 Location of manholes, receivers, and tributary infrastructure, including rim/invert elevations and pipeline sizes/direction.





- Location of water, natural fuel gas mains and valve boxes, driveways, sidewalks, trees, and cross streets (survey approximately 100 feet beyond the intersection). A design ticket will be requested through Dig Safely to obtain available existing infrastructure.
- Location and type of curbs.
- All existing structures and buildings within the project limits will be surveyed including front corner of structures and first floor elevation.
- Establishment of baseline along the centerline of the ROW.
- Elevations and cross sections will be taken every 50 feet and at all driveway locations along mainline baselines, respectively.
- Cross-sections at all cross streets every 25 feet for a distance of 100 feet beyond the intersection.
- Elevations secured at the street centerline, edge of curb, top of curb, and sidewalk centerline.
- Establishment of new benchmarks every 250 feet within the project area and will be placed at the base of the utility poles (pole spacing is approximately 200 feet) or utilizing existing fire hydrants.

GHD will provide two hard copies of the topographical survey map and an electronic copy on compact disk compatible with the latest version of AutoCAD.

2.2 Additional Services and Extra Work

We understand that items of work not included in the RFP shall not be performed without the authorization by the City Engineer. If additional work items are identified at a later date, GHD will prepare a separate proposal for review by the City Engineer and approval by the Common Council. The proposal will be presented in a similar format as this submission utilizing a lump sum fee or time and material format at the discretion of the City Engineer.

3. Proposed Schedule and Fee

GHD is available to begin within one week from authorization to proceed. We propose to complete the above Scope of Services for the lump sum fee of \$9,275.

Approval of the change order and project acceptance of the 2016 Storm Sewer Separation Project on Christiana Street is hereby requested. We have estimated that this project removed approximately 4 million gallons of stormwater annually from the city's sanitary sewer system. The change order represents the additional work required to install the storm sewer system as follows:

Horizontal conflicts/alignment change at Christiana/Vandervoort

\$10,860.70

• Extend new sewer to separate Lincoln Avenue to City Hall Lot

\$29,863.34

\$40,724.04

Costs for extra work were measured and based on unit bid prices extant in the contract.

The extremely favorable bid of the project allowed the city to include the removal of stormwater from the sanitary sewer on Lincoln Avenue up to the parking lots at City Hall. The savings from the project permits the city to perform more work under the 2017 Storm Sewer Separation Program.

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
