- The mayor's office received a call from a concerned citizen who stated that there needed to be a speed limit sign on Wall Street. Member Daigler will look into this problem and administer any signs that are needed.
- 2. An anonymous caller stated that the area of Ruie Road between Nash Road and Vanderbilt Drive should be an all year school zone due to the Boces program that runs all year. The Boces program is connected to the new intermediate school. Mayor Pappas and Assistant City Attorney Robinson agreed. Member Daigler will add signs to each end of the school zone which state "School All Year".
- A concerned citizen informed Member Frank that the "NO Turn on Red" sign at River Road and Ward Road was not being obeyed during the Gratwick Park concerts. NTPD patrols will watch the intersection.
- 4. An anonymous neighbor wanted the committee to check the area of Warner Road and Frontier Avenue for numerous vehicles parked in the street, which they believe is a traffic hazard. 



Dear Honorable Body;

Please see enclosed for a proposed Inter-Municipal Agreement (IMA) between City of North Tonawanda, City of Niagara Falls, and Town of Wheatfield. This IMA pertains to the proposed construction of a bicycle/pedestrian trail primarily through Wheatfield and connecting to existing paths in North Tonawanda and Niagara Falls.

The proposed path would approximately follow River Road and would complete the Niagara Shoreline Trail connecting Buffalo to Niagara Falls along the Niagara River shore. The majority of the project takes place within Wheatfield but would require a small section of path be built in North Tonawanda from the Wheatfield town line to Witmer Road, creating safe connection to Gratwick Park. This project is pending grant funding applications by the Town of Wheatfield and City of Niagara Falls.

Completion of the Niagara Shoreline Trail is a regionally significant effort and will also help residents of North Tonawanda better connect to the rest of the Buffalo Niagara region. At this time I'd like to request consider authorizing the enclosed Inter-Municipal Agreement.
