

As you are aware, the City of North Tonawanda has undertaken and completed the New York State Brownfield Opportunity Area (BOA) program. Directed by Bergmann Associates, this program has incorporated input from City departments, local stakeholder groups, local businesses, and city residents to establish a redevelopment plan for the BOA area of downtown and the Niagara River waterfront. In order to finalize the BOA program a number of procedural steps remain, including completion of the City SEQR requirements, drafting and finalization of an Environmental Impact Statement, issuance of a Findings Statement, and adoption of zoning code revisions.

Attached please find a resolution for your consideration to advance the SEQR process. This resolution affirms that the adoption of the BOA is a Type 1 SEQR action, that Parts 1, 2, and 3 of the Full SEQR Environmental Assessment were prepared and this Council made a positive declaration of potential significant adverse environmental impact, that the North Tonawanda Brownfield Opportunity Area Implementation Strategy/ DGEIS and Zoning Code Update is adequate for public review, and that public review and comments on the full BOA, Zoning Code, and DGEIS documents will open from October 17, 2018 through November 16, 2018. The complete documents will also be posted to the City website.
