Dear Honorable Mayor Pappas and Common Council:

Recently the Building Department has brought to my attention a concern of illegal chicken coops and cages throughout the City of North Tonawanda. Section 57 of the North Tonawanda City Code- Livestock, lays out how to properly go about receiving a permit for a Chicken Coup. This section also lays out the penalties for not getting the proper paperwork.

Due to the concern from citizens and the building department I recommend changing the penalty of this section of the code if the procedures are not followed. Currently the code reads as follows:

Any person, firm or corporation violating any provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of an offense and, upon conviction, be punished by a fine of not more than \$50 or by imprisonment for not more than six months, or by both.

I recommend the following changes:

Any person, firm or corporation violating any provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of an offense and, upon conviction, be punished by a fine of not more than \$50 per **day for each offense** or by imprisonment for not more than six months, or by both.

§ 25-8 Late filing; failure to schedule inspections; penalties for offenses.

[Amended 5-3-1994]

## Α.

Any person who shall commence construction of any building or other structure without first obtaining the required building permit shall be required to pay, as a penalty, a fee of twice the amount of the regular fee when making late application for such building permit. Whenever any person shall commence such construction without having first obtained a building permit, the Building Inspector shall stop all construction. Anyone failing to obtain a building permit within one business day after a stop-work order has been issued shall be subject to a fine not to exceed \$250 in addition to payment of the double fee for such late filing.

# <u>A.</u>

Whenever any person shall commence such construction without having first obtained a permit, the Building Inspector shall stop all construction. Anyone failing to obtain a permit within one business day after a stop-work order has been issued shall be subject to a fine not to exceed \$250 in addition to payment of the double fee for such late filing. 

Honorable Body;

In November 2017, the City entered into a one-year contract with the Wester New York Law Center (WNYLC) to assist with the implementation of a zombie property remediation program under a grant program funded by the Local Initiative Support Coalition (LISC) Zombie Property Prevention grant.

To date, WNYLC has completed the research, outreach, and training portions of the grant scope of work. See the attached summary page for a listing of project accomplishments. These services have been billed at \$18,055.95.

To complete the remaining deliverables of the LISC grant, I would like to hereby request the Council authorize an extension of the contact with the WNYLC through April 30, 2019. Expected deliverables are attached as well and include: continued outreach to homeowners facing foreclosure, hosting at least 2 more outreach/training public events, closer work with NT Code Enforcement to pursue banks holding zombie properties, research and policy preparation in consideration of a vacant property registry, and research and policy guidance for consideration of participation in the NY Mortgage Assistance Program for city residents.

WNYLC has proposed a fee of \$26,740.00 to provide these services to the City. This fee will be covered out of the remaining LISC grant funds with no direct cost to the City.

I hereby respectfully request the Common Council authorize the Mayor to extend the contract with Western New York Law Center, Inc, pending review and approval by the City Attorney, for Foreclosure Prevention/Remediation assistance at the proposed fee of \$26,740.00.

Proposed scope of work

The City of North Tonawanda proposes to extend its existing contract with the Western New York Law Center to accomplish the following:

- Manually track lis pendens filings
- · Send outreach postcards to homeowners facing foreclosure
- · Research new vacant properties and update research on existing vacant properties
- Host two more outreach and/or training events
- Collaborate with code enforcement to continue to keep pressure on bank, servicers, and maintenance companies regarding compliance with zombie foreclosure law
- Collaborate with City attorney to create progressive policies to protect homeowners facing tax foreclosure including the establishment of a vacant property registry system and possibly a landlord registry system
- Provide City of North Tonawanda with resolution and guidance procedures to assist with the establishment of the vacant property registry system
- Provide City of North Tonawanda with a draft resolution for consideration of making accommodations for property owners at risk of losing their home through tax foreclosure but eligible for NY Mortgage Assistance Program loans.
- Begin targeted outreach to residents eligible for NY Mortgage Assistance Program loans.
