Please be advised that this office sent out a Request for Proposal (RFP) on November 6, 2018 to four (4) qualified consultants for the renewal of claims management and loss control services for the City of North Tonawanda. A three person team was formed to evaluate the proposals received. This team consisted of City Accountant, Amanda Reimer, City Attorney, Luke Brown and the City's Personnel/Payroll Specialist, Jennifer Cress.

The evaluation of each firm was based on the following criteria: quality of proposal received, financial strength, reputation and stability of the firm, expertise, quality and experience of personnel, ability to provide value-added solutions in areas of risk management, loss control and claims management and cost-effectiveness. Two proposals were received by the City. Each proposal was ranked by the selection team. Based on the criteria defined above, and interviews conducted with the firms, the proposals solicited for and received were ranked as follows:

Consulting Firm	Cost	Score
Lawley Service, Inc.	\$22,500/annually	4.83
Self-Funding Inc.	\$28,000/annually	2.93
NCA Comp	No proposal submitted	n/a
KBM Management	No proposal submitted	n/a

In addition to the proposals solicited for and received, our office was contacted by one additional person who was interested in being considered for the contract. This proposal was reviewed by the selection team but omitted from consideration due to lack of qualifications.

Based on our evaluation of the rating criteria and the annual cost to the City, it is our recommendation that Lawley Service, Inc., be awarded a three year contract, with two one-year options to renew, for an annual fee of \$22,500. The recommended contract start date will be effective April 1, 2019, upon review and approval of the City Attorney.

Traffic Safety Minutes:

The February 2019 meeting of the North Tonawanda Traffic Safety Committee was called to order at 1900 hours. Roll call showed the following members present: R. Frank, J. Sikora, M. Daigler, M. Lemke, D. Grinnell, M. Anastasi. The minutes from the previous meeting were read and accepted, the following new concerns/requests were discussed, and recommendations made.

 Mayor Pappas asked the committee to look into solutions for the Post Office regarding their Drive-Up mailboxes located on Goundry and Oliver Streets. The Post Office states they are having congestion problems that are causing near accidents.

-Solution 1: move one mailbox to the DMV parking lot and one mailbox to the Manhattan Street parking lot.

-Solution 2: move the Oliver Street mailbox to the DMV parking lot and move the Goundry Street mailbox closer to Vandervoort Street.

- Mark Berube received a complaint from the homeowner at 304 Drake Drive. The homeowner
  wanted "no parking" signs placed on her side of the street from Drake School to Warner Avenue
  to help out traffic in the morning. The committee looked into the complaint and believes that
  "no parking" signs would cause other problems. Member Sikora spoke to the homeowner. The
  request was denied.
- 3. Austic Tylec received a complaint regarding traffic light problems at River Road and Ward Road. The complaint is that the red light takes 6 to 8 minutes to change. Member Daigler looked into the complaint and did not see an issue with the traffic light cycling. Daigler will continue to monitor the traffic light and if there is a problem Daigler will contact the State Department of Transportation.
- 4. Robert Depaolo would like the committee to look into placing a "No Turn on Red" sign on the southbound side of Erie Avenue at Wurlitzer Drive to leave the intersection clear for the safe

 Member Grinnell would like the committee to look into the intersection at Erie Avenue and Meadow Drive to see if a left turn arrow is needed on Meadow Drive. The committee will monitor the intersection and discuss it at the next meeting.

A recent review by the Plumbing Board and Plumbing Inspector of Chapter 69 Plumbing Part 1, registration of Licensed Master Plumbers has revealed that other than a written policy requiring a minimum of ten (10) years of experience working directly for a Master Plumber in order to qualify to take the Master Plumbing exam. Since "Policy" may be hard to enforce and in order to avoid any questions as to the 10 year work experience requirement the Board has requested that the Council change Chapter 69, Section 69-1B to include said requirement as well as Section 69-2 and 69-3 whereby the word "City Clerk" is replace by "Plumbing Inspector" as to who will receive and issued Plumbing licenses.

Attached please find a copy of Chapter 69, 69-1, 69-2 and 69-3 with the proposed changes highlighted in red.

Part 1 Registration of Licensed Master Plumbers

[Adopted 6-17-1957]

Chapter 69 Plumbing Part 1 Registration of Licensed Master Plumbers

### Article I

§ 69-1 Annual registration; surety bond; liability insurance.

§ 69-2 Plumbing permits not granted to unregistered plumbers.

§ 69-3 Registration fee; plumbing exam application.

### Article I

§ 69-1 Annual registration; surety bond; liability insurance.

[Amended 2-5-1974; 8-6-1974; 11-19-1974; 11-6-1978]

### A.

Each person duly licensed and engaging in business as a plumber within the City of North Tonawanda, New York, shall register annually with the Plumbing Inspector. Such registration shall take place during the month of December 1979 and shall be for a period of one-year commencing on the first day of January 1980 and shall run from January 1 to December 31 in each successive year, as provided in § 50 of the General Cities Law of the State of New York.

### B.

No registration shall become effective until and unless the following conditions are met:

- (1)A Master Plumber's license shall be issued by the Plumbing Inspector to any person upon receipt of a certificate from the Examining Board of Plumbers showing that such person has satisfactorily passed the examination held at said Board and upon receipt of the licensed fee therefore.
- (a) The applicant shall have a minimum of ten (10) years of practical experience in the trade of Plumbing and Drainage under the supervision of a master plumber. Proof of practical experience shall be submitted to the examiners before being admitted to the examination.

(2)

Effective March 1, 2016, a surety bond is no longer required.

(3)

Liability insurance.

(a)

The plumber shall file written evidence that there is in force and effect a liability insurance policy issued by an insurance company authorized to do business in the State of New York to secure and hold the City and its officers harmless against any and all claims, judgments or other costs arising by reason of the issuance of permits to the plumber for which the City, the City Council or any City officer may be made liable by reason of any action or injury to persons or property through the fault of the plumber or for any other injury resulting from the negligence of the plumber. Such insurance shall cover collapse, explosive hazards and underground work by equipment on the street and shall include protection against liability arising from completed operations. The amounts of the liability shall be in the amount of at least \$1,000,000 liability for injuries to one person and \$2,000,000 liability for injuries sustained in each accident and also against legal liability for property damage in the amount of not less than \$100,000, and such policy shall also state that it shall remain in full force without change until the expiration thereof, and it shall not be terminated or canceled for any reason or cause except after 10 days written notice of such proposed termination or cancellation has been duly served upon the City. Such insurance shall also contain a hold-harmless clause or endorsement to provide that the permittee shall save and hold harmless the City of North Tonawanda from any and all damages and liability by reason of bodily injury or property damage arising either directly or indirectly from the work to be performed by the permittee, irrespective of the cause of such injury or damage.

C.

The City Clerk is hereby authorized to issue licenses for the six-month period from July 1, 1979, to December 31, 1979. The Plumbing Inspector and City Attorney are hereby authorized to approve surety bonds and liability insurance policies for said same sixmonth period until January 1, 1980, when such registration, surety bonds and liability insurance will run from January 1 to December 31, as provided in § 69-1A. § 69-2 Plumbing permits not granted to unregistered plumbers.

Any plumber who shall not so register at the office of the Plumbing Inspector during the month of December in each year will not be granted any permits for plumbing construction or installations after January 1, until such time as he has duly registered as aforesaid.

§ 69-3 Registration fee; plumbing exam application.

[Amended 11-6-1978; 5-3-1994; 2-6-2004; 4-20-2005; 12-20-2016]

Each person so registering shall pay to the Plumbing Inspector an annual fee of \$125. Furthermore, each person so registering must obtain a certificate of competency from the Examining Board of Plumbers. In order to obtain the same, a plumbing exam is required to be taken by each person and there shall be a nonrefundable application fee paid at the time of filing of said application in the amount of \$125



I am writing to update you on our progress with the Lumber Baron District project, which we began in the fall of 2018. At our community meeting in September, our consultant KTA Preservation Specialists let us know that upon further research into the project, the name would be updated to Sweeney Estate District. The initial survey of homes took place in late December/Early January. A preliminary submission was made to the State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO) in January. The SHPO responded, requesting us to extend the boundaries of the survey area (per the attached map) and resubmit further documentation for review. This work will take place in late March, if approved. Once the boundaries are finalized by SHPO, KTA can complete the national register nomination and complete the project in September.

Due to the fact that the SHPO has requested additional homes to be surveyed, we will need additional grant funds to perform this work and complete the project. The attached application will be in front of you and council for review and approval next week.

By obtaining national register standing with the Sweeney Estate District, we are providing all home owners in the district the opportunity to improve their homes (inside and out) and receive tax credit money back. Participating in the program is strictly voluntary and up to the individual home owner. The benefit of the program is in maintaining the architectural integrity of our historic neighborhoods and improving their aesthetic. This results in increased property values and a deeper sense of pride in the community.
